

## School Council meeting minutes

30<sup>th</sup> October 2019

1. Welcome from Mrs Locke.
2. We listened to the feedback from Miss Esom regarding lunchtime concerns raised last time; some damaged equipment will be replaced but children also need to take more care; Premier Sports have been asked to offer more variety; adults have been reminded that NO children are allowed in any of the sheds; the forest area has been fenced off from the field and sessions will begin this half term; MDSA's have had a meeting about the rota for coming in to eat lunch, our behaviour policy and closing the field.
3. Fundraising ideas for Children In Need were suggested. Mr Bishop joined our meeting and we decided we would join in with the Joe Wicks Big Move each day (11<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> November) Monday-Thursday in our classrooms and Friday in turns in the hall. We will wear sports clothing instead of uniform on the Friday. We will make and take home a charity money box on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November to put sponsorship money in which needs to be returned THURSDAY 14<sup>th</sup> November. The class with the most money raised will earn an afternoon of golden time on the Friday.
4. School council will run a tuck shop on both playgrounds on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> break time instead of the kitchen tuck shop. Suggested products are oranges, apples, popcorn, juice boxes, milkshakes, plain milk, brioche rolls, raisins, nut free cereal bars. Mrs Locke will source prices and purchase a variety of snack items. This will be a trial to run a regular tuck shop in the future.
5. School council members will speak in Key Stage assemblies to share fundraising plans; KS2 Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> November; KS1 Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> November; EY snack time Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November.
