

At Lakenheath Primary School, we use the Primary Advantage Maths Programme to structure and support our Mathematics teaching. It is a model of best practice designed by Hackney Learning Trust and successfully rolled out across Hackney borough schools to improve mathematics attainment. It fully complies with the 2014 National Curriculum and enables our teachers to carefully plan for progression within and between their daily lessons. It uses a CPA model – concrete, pictorial, abstract – to introduce children to mathematical skills and concepts using apparatus, images and models to aid their learning. Each strand of mathematics has stepped learning intentions designed to both support and challenge the children in their maths learning. Alongside the PA programme, our teachers embed the use of Assessment for Learning in order to progress check and give feedback to the children about their learning. Each child is aware of what they are learning and how to be successful in their learning through shared learning intentions and steps to success. We enjoy learning contextualised, real life mathematics.
