Phonemes we will be focusing on this week in school -



Pronunciation Phrase - sh

Show me your teeth and push the air out **shshshsh**



Pronunciation Phrase - th

Voiced: Tongue on your teeth, teeth almost closed to make a 'buzzing' **th**

Unvoiced: Tongue on your teeth and push the air out th

Pronunciation Phrase - nk



Open your mouth a bit and then use your tongue at the back of your mouth to say **ng ng ng**

Pronunciation Phrase - ng



Open your mouth a bit and then use your tongue at the back of your mouth to say **ngk ngk ngk**
