

Facts at your fingertips - online library resources for students and families



There are many resources available from Suffolk Libraries to help teachers, parents and children whilst schools are closed.

A new addition to Suffolk Libraries' extensive eLibrary is the Britannica Kids' Encyclopedia. All eight volumes are now available to download and explore as eBooks via Suffolk Libraries' OverDrive service.

The encyclopedias are available as unlimited titles so there is no limit to the number of copies which can be downloaded and enjoyed.

Britannica children's encyclopaedias are fantastic for homework - the information is everything you could want; reliable, accurate, up-to-date and accessible. The eBooks are also perfect for kids with curious minds that love reading facts. Encyclopaedias offer information in chunks, so they are excellent for browsing through, learning about our world (and the universe beyond) and finding fascinating facts to think about and share.

The encyclopedias cover titles including Universe, Life, Humans, Ancient and Medieval Times and Modern Times. You can access the titles via the <u>Overdrive</u> <u>service</u> and there is more information on how to sign up and access the service for free on the <u>Suffolk Libraries website</u>.

The eLibrary service also provides many other titles for children and young people. Parents can also access the free Kanopy streaming services which includes Kanopy Kids and a wide range of courses and films.

You can find resources for <u>home schooling</u> on the Suffolk Libraries website including support for teachers and homework help.
