Dear Parents/ Carers,

We had an unplanned fire alarm yesterday morning. Fortunately, this was a false alarm. It has, however, flagged up some points for improvement:

- 2. We had not received phone-calls by 9am in the morning to report absences.

Uniform

Just a reminder that the children should still be in their Winter Uniform. After the Easter holidays, children will be expected to be in their summer uniform and can then wear shorts, skorts or summer dresses.

We have noticed a number of girls wearing leggings every day. These are only permitted on PE days and are not part of our usual school uniform. PE kits must be worn for PE - sports shirts, football kits and hoodies are NOT permitted. We will be having a crackdown on this in the summer term and sending reminders home to individuals. Please use the Easter holidays to replenish with the correct uniform and in cases of hardship please speak to us at school as we are able to source pre-loved uniform where necessary.

Any shoulder length hair must be tied back for health and safety reasons [including the spread of headlice] and this should stay up all day. A number of children are removing hair ties at lunchtimes which is not allowed. Hair adornments should be small and only in school colours please: purple, blue, black, white.
